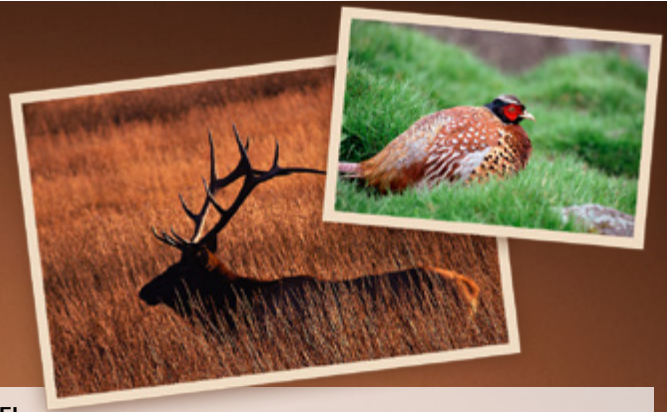

<b>Bass, striped and hybrid striped</b> (also known as palmetto or sunshine bass)	5 (in any combo)	18 inches
<b>Bass, white</b>	25	10 inches
<b>Bass, yellow</b>	No limit	No minimum
<b>Catfish:</b> channel and blue, their hybrids and subspecies	25 (in any combo)	12 inches
Catfish, flathead	5	18 inches
<b>Crappie:</b> white and black, their hybrids and subspecies	25 (in any combo)	10 inches
<b>Paddlefish</b>	No harvest allowed	
<b>Gar, alligator</b>	1	No minimum
<b>Saugeye</b>	3	18 inches
<b>Sunfish:</b> various species including bluegill, redear, green, warmouth and longear	No limit	No minimum
<b>Trout:</b> rainbow and brown, their hybrids and subspecies	5 (in any combo)	No minimum
<b>Walleye</b>	5	Only 2 can be less than 16 inches in length
